

Team Clothing - When Can I Wear What?

Required Items

1. Practice Dress – New this year, by request of many parents. The practice dress is worn at every Tuesday practice. (Applies to Open Juv, too; pants may be worn Sat. a.m.) It may also be used for official practice ice at competition arenas, where all skaters must be dressed alike and should be in skating dresses (vs. pants). Beg. 1&2 will receive a long-sleeved version; Beg. 3 & Open Juv will receive a tank-top version. It is a higher quality dress from a more reputable company; thus, not as cheap as last year - but still a good price at \$57-\$59.
2. Practice Fleece – worn at every practice and to competition. Open Juv is using the same black, cotton jacket as last season; order if you need it.
3. Practice Tights – heavy, footless tights used for warmth over any pair of regular tights or socks at practice. Keeps tights from running too!
4. Black Jazz Pants – Part of the competition uniform, along with the Team T-Shirt. These pants *may* also be used at practice during the winter months, at the discretion of the coach. If you already own these, you do not have to order another pair; they're the same and last forever...unless you've grown.
5. Competition Tights – Footed tights worn under the competition dress.
6. Team T-shirt – Part of the competition uniform. Each shirt will have a design with the team's theme on the back.

Optional Items

1. Team Parka – There is a new team parka, at a reduced cost, that is available to Beginner skaters (or Open Juv skaters if desired). Open Juv will be using the existing parka again (required for OJ). The parka is not intended for on-ice use, but mainly to wear to competition or to the rink. In frigid conditions, it may be allowed on-ice for practice – depending upon how slippery it is to hold on to!
2. Under Armor – available to wear with the practice dress or tank during winter months, if needed.
3. Leg Warmers – available for practice at the rink only. Not to be worn for any official competition practices.
4. Grippy Gloves – **HIGHLY RECOMMENDED**. Regular gloves are not allowed at practice, as they are too slippery for handholds. Your own (non-team) grippy gloves would be ok to wear.
5. Skate Bag – Obvious use is to carry skates ☺ Open Juv is required to have this bag; same style every year, so a new one is not needed. Embroidery on the bags is now available, including logo and name.

Spirit Wear
